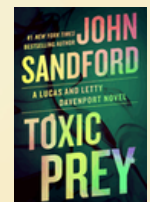
Funny Story

The Final Curse of Ophelia Cray

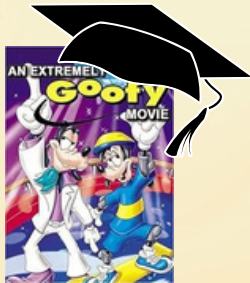

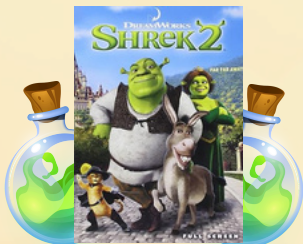

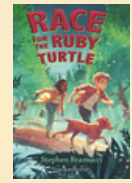
Books For Young Readers

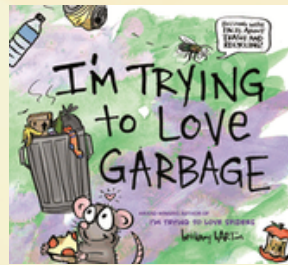
Race for the Ruby Turtle
