Nutcracker By Susan Adrian

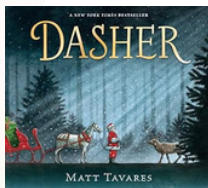

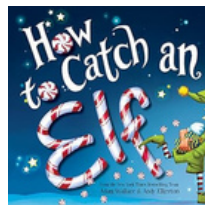
